Based on this information for the class F3P, 41 competitors are going to participate, so for the final rounds the top 12 competitors from the preliminary rounds will be selected. For the class F3P AFM 24 competitors are going to participate, so for the final rounds the top 10 competitors from the preliminary rounds will be selected.

ANTI-DOPING

If a competitor has to take, for medical conditions, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List, he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) approved by FAI which will issue the TUE Certificate. Since the Prohibited List is updated by WADA not on a regular base, it is recommended to review from time to time the full section for Anti-Doping in the FAI Web site, <https://fai.org/anti-doping>. You will find all the necessary information and not only.

In addition you will find together with this Bulletin the FAI Anti-Doping Form attached which has to be filled and signed and return to the organizer during the official registration to the event.

COMPLIANCE WITH THE RULES FORM

According to the rules, each competitor will have to fill the attached form and return it to the organizer during the official registration to the event. This form has to be signed by the competitor and the team manager.

F3P AFM CLASS

This is the first time that this class will be part of the official event. For this reason and in order to assist the organizer, it is required to send the music schedule of your program for both preliminary and final rounds. For the final rounds those who will take part shall use two music schedules according to the rules.

You will find attached a so called "Music Form" which has to be returned to the organizer **by March 10 at the latest**. This form has to be accompanied by electronic files which will include your music schedule or schedules. For better quality it is recommended to deliver those files in "wav" format. The file name shall have the following naming format. Country Name_competitor number (you can get this from the list included with this bulletin – last column)_S1 or S2 (for schedule 1 or schedule 2). For example: GREECE_122_S1.wav.

On the form you will need to write your preference for the preliminary and the final rounds. Please include the initiating signals (beeps) with your schedule. This will assist the time keeper to identify when the actual time is starting. The timer will start counting at the beginning of the music which has to start right after the last initiating signal.

MODEL AIRCRAFT SPECIFICATIONS CERTIFICATES

All models must be processed by the competitor's NAC in accordance with CIAM General Rules C.12. Model aircraft not properly processed by the NAC, with FAI certificates and stickers, will be processed by the organiser at a cost of 8 Euro for each model.

From the web site of the event you will be able to download the FAI Sticker template and the Model certificate plus the form that will be used for the model processing as a guideline to assist your preparation for this task.

REGISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL TEAMS

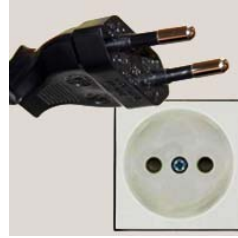
The team-manager needs to bring for the registration at the arrival day of his national team:

- Two national flags (approx. 1 m x 1.5 m).
- CD/DVD/USB stick with the national anthem (wav or mp3 format).
- The Model Aircraft Specification Certificates will be required for processing of the models.
- FAI Anti-Doping Form for each competitor
- Technical Compliance Form for each competitor

The Team Manager will receive at the registration of his team: Accreditation Cards, Lunch and Banquet tickets, etc.

ELECTRICITY

Electricity 50Hz/220 Volt power will be provided on site. Each team may bring their own power converters and plug adapters to Greek standard outlets. The same kind of outlets is going to be available at the hotels.
